

Fossil Rehousing Workshop for Eastern Montana Museums

On May 29, we sponsored a Fossil Rehousing Workshop for small museums in eastern Montana. The Carter County Museum, in partnership with the Museums Association of Montana, provided training to staff and volunteers from six organizations. Attendees received the tools and skills necessary to rehouse fossil specimens in physically and chemically stable environments for long term storage.



The Best Gift: Montana's Carnegie Libraries

Fifteen of those libraries stand today, and their story is compellingly told here by architectural historian Kate Hampton. 
